Legendary pairing in Eden project

Eden Valley Riesling 2002,
South Australia



A new joint venture brings together two of Eden Valley's foremost Riesling producers. Jeffrey Grosset, famed for his Polish Hill Riesling, and Robert Hill Smith, from Yalumba, Australia's oldest family-owned winery, have combined their talents to produce mesh - a blend of wines from two of the producers' best vineyard properties.

Explaining the choice of name, Hill Smith says: "This single word represents so much of the philosophy behind the wine - the weaving together of ideas and the combining of skills and knowledge."

A jointly agreed philosophy and wine style has produced a rich, citrus flavour with a slight mineral profile, typical of the Eden Valley. Sourced equally from each producer's vineyards, the wine is intended to elevate the status of both Riesling and the Eden Valley region.
