South Australia

When two wine luminaries such as Jeffrey Grosset and Robert Hill Smith put their name to a Stelvin-topped Eden Valley Riesling you can be sure people will take notice. Speculation will surely abound. Could this be Australia's best Riesling? Either way, the **mesh** is bloody good.

A very pale straw colour, it's bursting with fresh lime, floral and herbal aromatics that are pure Eden Valley. The palate simply confirms what your nose has already told you - that this is a wine of amazing precision and purity, with buckets of varietal and regional definition. While it's absolutely crisp and delicious now, it's a beautifully structured wine with plenty of intensity which bodes well for a decent spell in the cellar too.
