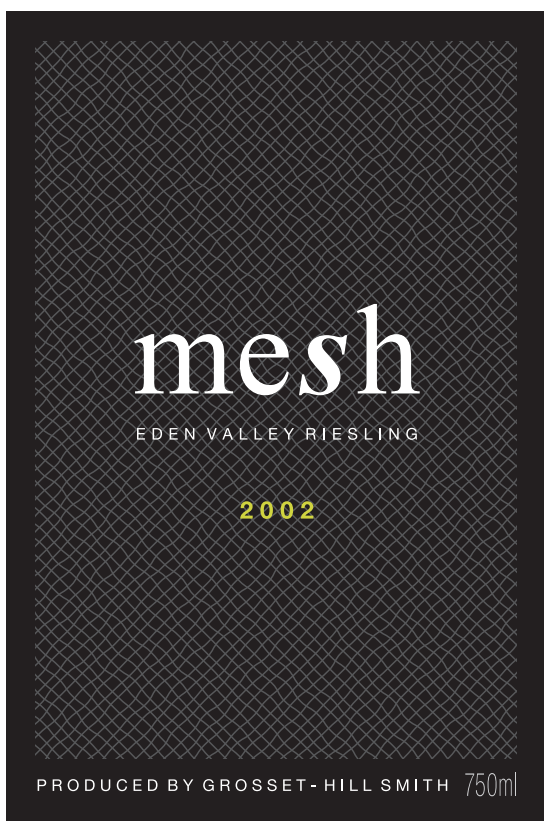

mesh Eden Valley Riesling 2002



Supple, dry, full bodied, and very intensely flavored; an exceptional Riesling, with excellent flavor, balance, and length. Tastes of jasmine, clove, honeysuckle, apple, and peach. Should develop well with bottle aging. (2003-2007)

Rarely do Australian Rieslings perform at the level of the European counterparts, notably from Germany, Alsace, or Austria. This one does. A wine produced as a joint project between one of Australia's top Riesling producers, Jeffrey Grosset, and Robert Hill Smith of Yalumba, **mesh** was conceived as a wine to reflect the character of top, dry, Eden Valley Riesling. The wine was made from Riesling grown in two old-vine Riesling vineyards, and produced at two separate facilities. The wines then were blended ("meshed") by the two partners into a wine that is a wonderful expression of Riesling, similar to a top Austrian version, with the slightest hint of New World flesh and fruit. An amazing wine.
